FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens at the event?

Your team (and any spectators) will be asked to arrive at least 30 minutes before you are scheduled to pull the plane. We'll check you in and make sure team members have signed a waiver. Team members receive a complimentary BBQ lunch (guests can purchase for \$5) and you enjoy entertainment and other fun activities.

When your team is called, you will be guided through a fun warm-up, inspired by our motivational coaches, photographed and outfitted with gloves (or you can bring your own). On our mark, you will all pull on the rope as hard and fast as you can to get that plane moving! Your time will be recorded for a chance to win the coveted Fastest Time trophy. It's not all about speed and strength—there are trophies and prizes for team spirit, creative entrance onto the tarmac and best costumes, so show us what you are made of! Note: For safety reasons, animals are not permitted on Kelowna Flightcraft property.

Your team will receive a souvenir photograph to proudly display in your office. Best of all, you'll be part of an unforgettable experience that will build up both your team and your community. Be sure to challenge your competitors to enter too!

How do we raise the \$750 registration fee?

- If needed, we can give you pledge forms to have each person on your team raise funds through their networks. *If you break it down amongst 12 team members, each person has to raise just \$62.50!*
- Hold fun events (such as BBQs or pancake breakfasts). This is a great way to engage others around you in the Valley First Plane Pull Challenge and raise awareness about the value of United Way in your community. *United Way can provide you with a list of over 100 fundraising ideas.*

When are registration fees due?

Please notify United Way of your intent to enter a team as soon as possible, so that we can plan for you on the event schedule and make sure you receive waivers, follow-up instructions etc. You can notify us of intent to enter by sending an e-mail to avril@unitedwaycso.com or calling 250-860-2356.

Fees may be submitted right up until the event, but reserving time slots is strictly "first paid, first served" so it is advisable to secure your registration by paying your fees and submitting your form as early as you can. If you wish, you may leave a credit card number on file at our office to reserve your time slot while raising funds.

What if our team raises more than \$750?

The sky is the limit when it comes to creating impact in your community—there will be a prize for the team that raises the most funds above the \$750 fee!

Companies are welcome to enter more than 1 team in the event. The \$750 fee applies to each team entering.

Can we get a tax receipt?

Yes! Guidelines for receiving a tax receipt are as follows:

The \$750 registration fee (and any additional funds raised by your team) will be eligible for a tax receipt from United Way.

IMPORTANT: In order to issue tax receipts, United Way must receive all of the following information at the time that payment is submitted:

- First and last names of any donors who have contributed funds to the team registration fee.
- Complete addresses including postal code.
- Individual donation amount (minimum \$20 to receive tax receipt).

United Way invests funds raised through the Valley First Plane Pull Challenge to provide essential services to children and youth, vulnerable adults, and seniors. Everyone wins when your team steps onto the tarmac!
