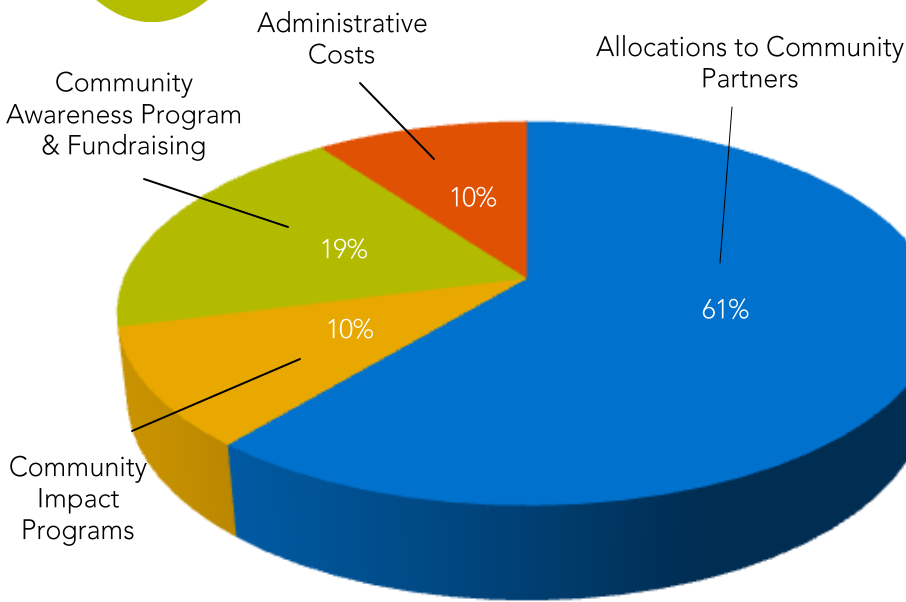




# United Way Program Funding

**Success By 6**  
An early childhood development initiative dedicated to providing all children with a good start in life that has coordinators throughout our region.

**Days of Caring** are community-wide expressions of the power of group volunteering. The United Way Days of Caring Program matches teams of volunteers (from a workplace, service club, youth group, sports team etc.) to volunteer projects that benefit non-profit agencies.

**GenNext Leadership Cabinet**  
Opportunities for young professionals to develop leadership and volunteer opportunities in our community.

**Emergency Transportation Program**  
Distribute bus tickets to community agencies to assist their clients in accessing emergency social services.

**Youth Initiatives Grants**  
A new initiative for youth to develop and implement local projects that create lasting social change.

**Community Conversations**  
Allow United Way to engage with local citizens around the issues that matter most to them. These conversations bring diverse people with common experiences together as a catalyst for social change.

**Allocations Impact Teams**  
Volunteer teams who meet with our Community Partners to determine how to effectively provide resources to meet the needs of their clients.

**Building Capacity**  
Workshops and training programs at reasonable costs for non-profit organizations to build capacity for healthy strong organizations.
