Princeton (October 31, 2017) – United Way CSO staff delivered 5 car seats to the Princeton Family Services Society on Tuesday as part of the Child Safety Initiative, a unique partnership between United Way CSO, Central Okanagan Foundation and KGH Foundation who joined forces again to purchase 84 car seats at a discounted rate through corporate partner Costco Kelowna. Budget Car and Truck Rentals donated the cube van for the South Okanagan/Similkameen trip. Eligible families in Princeton who can't afford a car seat are able to pick them up from the Family Centre.
