United Way delivers car seats for families in need to Summerland Food Bank

Summerland (October 31, 2017) – United Way CSO staff delivered 5 car seats to the Summerland Food Bank and Resource Centre on Tuesday as part of the Child Safety Initiative, a partnership between United Way CSO, Central Okanagan Foundation and KGH Foundation who joined forces again to purchase car seats at a discounted rate through corporate partner Costco Kelowna. Budget Car and Truck Rentals donated the cube van for the South Okanagan/Similkameen trip. Eligible families in Summerland who can't afford a car seat are able to apply for them at the Resource Centre.
