- 2 hours for training and orientation (April)
- 9-12 hours total reviewing applications, meeting organizations and completing assessments (April-May).

- Ability to lead, coordinate and collaborate with others.
- A keen eye to task management and detail.
- Understanding of social issues is an asset.
- Y Knowledge of financial management is an asset.
- Professionalism and strong communication skills.
- Willingness to act as an Ambassador on behalf of the United Way
- Y Ability to be decisive.
