Point-in-time Living Conditions Survey

West Kelowna and Westbank First Nation are partnering to carry out a Point-in-Time Living Conditions Survey for the Westside. The purpose of the assessment/survey is to gather information on the number of people who are experiencing housing challenges or homelessness in the community and collect some basic demographic information through a survey. It will help the community better understand how many people are facing housing or homelessness challenges, and the information will help direct future programs, housing, supports, policy changes etc.


Volunteer Duties

We are currently looking for volunteers to assist with administering the survey or supporting lunch and dinner preparation. Lunch and dinner volunteers would assist with food preparation and serving meals at a survey location. Survey volunteers will be in teams, each led by a person with experience working with vulnerable populations in the community, and administer the survey throughout the community.

Time Commitment (7hrs)

The time commitment includes 3 hours of mandatory survey and cultural sensitivity training (the week of July 16-19, TBD) and a 3-4 hour commitment on the day of the Point-in-Time Living Conditions Survey (the week of July 23-26, TBD).
